Both Deuteronomy 6:6-9 and Ephesians 6:1-4 articulate the reality that parents are the primary trainers of their children. They often need to learn how to do it.

#3 The Heart is Crucial

God is interested in the hearts of children so parents need heart-based strategies to train them. Most parents want to reach the hearts of their kids, they just need to learn how to do it.



Parent Ministry can look different in each church because of the uniqueness of the congregation, but all parent ministry contains a few common characteristics.

WE DISCIPLE PARENTS

The church views the discipleship mandate to be more than helping individuals be stronger Christ followers to the extent that people are being equipped in their roles and relationships in family life.

OUR LEADERS VALUE PARENT MINISTRY

Leadership views parent training as a church wide discipleship goal not merely an adjunct of the children's ministry.

WE HAVE A PARENTING RESOURCE PERSON

A person is identified in the church who is the stimulus for parent care.

7 Characteristics of a Church as a Parent Training Center

WE OFFER SEVERAL METHODS OF SUPPORT

A multi-faceted approach to parent support and training is available through the church using several vehicles such as online support groups, parent training meetings, family nights, resource of the month, live seminars, and/or one-on-one family mentoring.

PARENTS ARE OFFERED MULTIPLE ONRAMPS

Parents are aware of the onramps to the parent training programs including prayer support, resources, and mentoring opportunities.

WE USE PARENT TRAINING AS AN OUTREACH TO THE COMMUNITY

Parents outside the church learn about the parent training resources available (i.e. court mandated parent education, foster and adoptive parent education, and help for traditional and non-traditional families).

WE USE A BIBLICAL APPROACH

Various topics are addressed throughout the church programs including child development, parenting techniques, with the Bible applied to family life.

NATIONAL CENTER for BIBLICAL

Churches have a biblical mandate to disciple people, including children. Inviting parents into that process helps them catch a vision for discipleship and teaches them how to do it.

Families need guidance and instruction to understand how to accomplish the most in family life. Parents need tools and kids need to understand what expectations God has for them.

Provide Intergenerational

Equip Parents to be Spiritual **Trainers in Their Own Homes**

God has appointed parents to be the primary spiritual trainers of their kids, but they often need tools and training to know how to maximize prayer, Bible study, and spiritual interaction with their kids.

Deuteronomy 6:6-9



The National Center for Biblical Parenting has tools and resources to support churches as they develop their parenting ministries in all four of these areas.

1. Choose a Parent Resource Person

In the same way that a PTA functions for a school, you want help to address parents. Finding a key person to come along side you, but who remains under the authority of the church leadership, will maximize your effectiveness. You might have this person register as a Parent Resource Person with the National Center for Biblical Parenting to start receiving input and information about how to proceed. Click here to sign up.

2. Build a Parent Resource Team

These are people who will support the Parent Resource Person to help plan and organize various events and initiatives for parents. It's best to identify these people specifically as your team. They will be on the lookout for good ideas for discipling parents.

3. Identify Interested Parents

Start a list or data base of parents that might be interested in the discipleship ideas you have to offer. Identify those that are highly committed and want training and events, those that are prospects who could be trained, and those who have expressed interest from the community and need further follow up. You might even specify parents by the age of their kids or those with special needs, although most families overlap those types of groups. Each of these groups of people will receive different communication at times based on their interest and needs.

4. Establish Communication Tools

Determine with your Parent Resource Team the most effective tools for communicating to interested parents the ideas you have to offer. (i.e. bulletin inserts, email list, Facebook group)

Email Tips

Create an email list and pass on email parenting tips regularly. You can sign up for free email parenting tips from the National Center for Biblical Parenting here.

Small Group

Run a small group, 3-8 weeks, on parenting. You can obtain parent training video curriculum from the National Center for Biblical Parenting here.

Preaching

Preach a series on parenting and family or run the Family Challenge 90 Day Adventure. Learn more here.

Family Nights

Organize a monthly Family Night where parents are trained while children are learning things that complement what the parents are learning. The National Center for Biblical Parenting has a Family VBS program that can take place once a month for 8 months. Learn more here.

Mentoring

Provide a one on one mentoring program for parents. **Learn more here**.

Devotions Training

Train parents to do fun devotions with their kids.
The National Center for Biblical Parenting offers resources that help parents excite their kids about devotions. Learn more here.

A Live Seminar

Host a live parenting seminar at your church. This will provide extra energy that can start or ignite excitement in the parent ministry of your church. Learn more here.

Family Event

Plan a Family event or activity. The best events or activities that will contribute to your mission as a Parent Training Center are those that provide opportunities for parents to discuss ideas and challenges. However, even having families working together on a service project or playing games together allows parents to watch other Christian parents and learn from healthy modeling.

Prayer Team

Start a Prayer Team. Parents need prayer and so do their kids. It might be helpful to provide a vehicle like a closed Facebook group or an email to a grandparent prayer team to continually lift up specific prayer requests to the Lord.



A Suggested Road Map for Developing the Parenting Ministry in Your Church



EVALUATION/ PREPARATION STAGE

Time Frame: 1-2 Months

GOAL:

To inform and inspire leadership, recruit interested parents, and create the structures for communicating the program.

TOOLS

PARENTING IS HEART WORK

Time Frame: 6-9 Months

GOALS

To help parents move from reward/punishment models to a heart-based approach and to develop new patterns in family life.

PURPOSE

Parents must get two things going well in family life:

1) Getting things done without tension and resistance, and 2) Getting kids back on track when necessary. Parents need techniques and strategies that express a biblical approach to parenting.
